


# Embedding KeyShotVR in website

## Embedding KeyShotVR in a website

To embed a KeyShotVR in a website you will need to upload your KeyShotVR files to a webserver. Once the files have been uploaded you will need to use the `<iframe>` html tag to embed the KeyShotVR inside a webpage. The 'src' attribute will need to be set to the KeyShotVR URL.
